Immediate Response July 27 2017 Phillipsburg New Jersey

Skoda Foreman, Steven Csiszlak approached a home owner getting into her car to schedule the replacement of her natural gas service on Marshall Street in Phillipsburg NJ for Elizabethtown Gas Company.

She told him that she had been smelling gas in the house since her plumber did some furnace piping a few days prior.

Steve quickly gestured Skoda Pipe man Ken Burgio who had his gas measurement device with him. Upon entering the basement Ken found excessive gas readings in air and immediately removed her and himself from the building.

He turned off the supply of natural gas to the building. Steve Csiszlak notified ETG for a responder while Andrew Garrett went to the porch and evacuated the remaining person from the home and kept him and others from re-entering the home.
